

Robe of Righteousness

Isa. 61:10 *I will greatly rejoice in the Lord, my soul shall be joyful in my God; for He has clothed me with the garments of salvation, He has covered me with the robe of righteousness, as a bridegroom decks himself with ornaments, and as a bride adorns herself with her jewels.*

Isaiah 61:2b, 3 *To comfort all who mourn, To console those who mourn in Zion, to give them beauty for ashes, the oil of joy for mourning, the garment of praise for the spirit of heaviness*

Isaiah 59:17

*For he put on righteousness ⁶⁶⁶ as a breastplate, and an helmet of salvation upon his head; and he put on the garments ⁸⁹⁹ of vengeance [for] clothing, and was clad with zeal as a **cloak** ⁴⁵⁹⁸.*

Matt. 22:11, 12 *But when the king came in to see the guests, he saw a man there who did not have on a wedding **garment**. So he said to him, 'Friend, how did you come in here without a wedding **garment**?' And he was speechless.*

Mark 16:5 *And entering the tomb, they saw a young man clothed in a long white robe sitting on the right side; and they were alarmed.*

G1746 Garment

a) To sink into (clothing), put on, clothe one's self

Luke 15:22 Prodigal son (put on him the best robe)

Luke 24:49 Tarry in Jerusalem till you be endued with power

Rom. 13:12 – **Put On** armor of light (sink into)

Rom. 13:14 – **Put On** Lord Jesus (sink into)

2 Cor. 5:3 – not found naked – without our glory suits on

Gal 3:27 – baptized in Christ has put on Christ

Ephes. 4:24 – Put on new man

Ephes. 6:11 – Put on whole armor

1 Thess. 5:8 But let us who are of the day be sober, putting on the breastplate of faith and love, and as a helmet the hope of salvation,

Rev. 1:13 –.... One like the Son of Man, clothed with a garment down to the feet.....

(Appropriate – to take for oneself; to take possession of)

Righteousness is the state acceptable to God which becomes a sinner's possession through that faith by which he embraces the *grace* of God offered him in the expiatory (able to make atonement) death of Jesus Christ.

Grace –

New Testament - Divine influence upon the heart and its reflection in the life. Gr.5485

Old Testament - Graciousness, kindness, favor Heb. 2580

Righteousness G1343 in a broad sense: state of him who is as he ought to be, righteousness, the condition acceptable to God

SHAME 3639 kelimma – disgrace, reproach, shame, confusion, dishonor, insult, clothed with shame; altogether covered with reproach

Unworthy – Unfit for a thing

What Jesus Christ did for us:

Isaiah 50:6 *I gave My back to those who struck Me, and My cheeks to those who plucked out the beard; I did not hide My face from shame and spitting. (Matt. 26:67; 27:26,30)*

Isaiah 54:4 *Fear not, for you shall not be ashamed; neither be confounded and depressed, for you shall not be put to shame; for you shall forget the shame of your youth, and you shall not seriously remember the reproach of your widowhood anymore. Amp. Chapter 54 speaks of A Perpetual Covenant of Peace!*

Isaiah 61:7 *Instead of your shame you shall have double honor, and instead of confusion they shall rejoice in their portion. Therefore in their land they shall possess double; everlasting joy shall be theirs.*

2 Cor. 5:21 *For He made Him who knew no sin to be sin for us, that we might become the righteousness of God in Him. (Christ Jesus)*

Amp. *For our sake He made Christ virtually to be sin Who knew no sin, so that in and through Him we might become endued with, viewed as in and examples of the*

righteousness of God – what we ought to be, approved and acceptable and in right relationship with Him, by His goodness.

Ephes. 2:6 *and raised us up together, and made us sit together in the heavenly places in Christ Jesus*

Amp. *And He raised us up together with Him and made us sit down together – giving us joint seating with Him – in the heavenly sphere by virtue of our being in Christ Jesus, the Messiah, the Anointed One.*

Rev.1:5b, 6 *To Him who loved us and washed us from our sins in His own blood, and has made us kings and priests to His God and Father, to Him be glory and dominion forever and ever. Amen.*

Rev. 5:10 *And have made us kings and priests to our God; and we shall reign on the earth.*

I am a joint heir with Christ - (Rom 8:17)

I am a fellow citizen with the saints and of the household of God. (Ephes. 2:19) I belong.

I am complete in Him. – (Col. 2:10)

I am free from condemnation. - (Rom. 8:1)

I am reconciled to God. – (2 Cor. 5:18)

I am qualified to share in His inheritance. (Col 1:12)

I am raised up with Christ and seated in heavenly places. (Col. 2:12)

I am a partaker of His divine nature. (2Peter 1:4)

I am God's workmanship created in Christ Jesus for good works. (Ephes. 2:10)

I am one in Christ (John 17:21-22)

I am a priest and king unto God. (Rev. 1:6 & 5:10)
