THE HOPE OF GLORY: ALLOWING THE CHRIST IN YOU TO ARISE

INTRODUCTION

HOPE IN <u>GOD</u> IS A VERY <u>VITAL</u> AND IMPORTANT ASPECT IN OUR LIVES

- If hope doesn't arise in our <u>minds</u> or thinking, then our spirits will be weakened, but if confident <u>expectation</u> arises in us, then that is like a tree of life. (Proverbs 13:12)
- "Blessed is the man that trusteth in the Lord." (Jer. 17:7 KJV)
- "The Lord is my portion, saith my soul, therefore will I hope in Him." (Lamentations 3:24 KJV)

THE PRINCIPLE OF <u>HOPING</u> IN THE LORD HAS BECOME THE CALL OF THE LORD UPON ALL THOSE OF THE NEW COVENANT

"HOPE SPRINGS ETERNAL IN THE HUMAN BREAST." (ALEXANDER POPE)

DEFINITION OF HOPE

• The feeling that what one desires will happen.

THE THREE THINGS THAT ABIDE ETERNALLY – <u>FAITH, HOPE, LOVE</u> (1 COR. 13:13) - GROW OUT OF ONE ANOTHER

Definitions

- Faith Hebrews 11:1
 - A believing and relying on something (or someone) without proof
 - Synonymous with <u>trust</u>
- Hope a confidence and an <u>expectation</u> in that which one trusts
- Love to regard with <u>favor</u> or to make much of that which (or whom) one trusts and has confidence and expectation in

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Without faith, <u>hope</u> cannot spring eternal, and without faith and hope, <u>love</u> cannot become full and therefore the greatest of the abiding virtues.

HOW THESE ETERNAL VIRTUES DEVELOP IN OUR HEARTS AND LIVES

- Faith Romans 10:17 NKJV
 - "Faith comes by <u>hearing</u> and hearing by the Word of God."
 - Knowledge produces <u>faith.</u>
 - Knowledge about God and what He has done produces faith in God.
- Hope grows in us as we <u>hear</u> and understand and <u>believe</u> more of God's Word, for hope is merely a confident expectation in that which we have faith.
- As a result of learning to trust in God through the hearing of His Word, and then actually trusting and hoping, we more fully <u>love</u> God.
- It is through <u>love</u> that all our Lord represented and demonstrated here on earth can be carried on through us.

- He is in us to will and to do that which the <u>Father</u> wants done here on earth.
- Appropriating the "Christ in us" principle is our Lord's <u>call</u> upon our lives and is at the same time our <u>hope</u> of glory.

HOW TO APPROPRIATE THE PRINCIPLE OF "CHRIST IN US, THE HOPE OF GLORY" – HOW TO PERMIT AND PROMOTE "GOD ARISING IN US"

- <u>Meditate</u> upon the truth of God's Word that Christ is in us to will and to do the will of the Father until it becomes a present and constant <u>reality</u> in our minds and hearts.
- Constantly <u>remember</u> that allowing the Christ in us to arise is the only way that the true work of God can be <u>accomplished</u> on earth, for this scatters the enemy and allows God to send down His glory to man.
- After this truth is sealed in our hearts, then we who are subdued in the Lord and are hearkening to His Voice must actually <u>step out and do</u> that which we believe God wants done. God chooses to work here on earth through man. This is why He called out a people to Himself.
- We must be willing to <u>continue</u> in this hope of our calling until Christ comes again even if it requires self-sacrifice (Luke 9:62).

CONCLUSION

- Failure to <u>mature</u> in this concept of growing up in our confidence in the God within us is what holds most of us back today from doing the greater ministry in the Spirit.
