# LESSON 4 HIS WAY IS LOWLY

#### **INTRODUCTION**

TO BE SPIRITUAL TREES OF LIFE, WE MUST DEVELOP ROOTS OF RIGHTEOUSNESS

- We must be subdued in the Lord.
- We must learn to hearken to His voice.
- We must take hold of the <u>hope of glory</u> and allow God to rise up in us.
- We need to develop <u>meekness</u> and <u>lowliness</u> of heart.

#### EVERY LIVING TREE OF NATURE HAS TWO DISTINCT PROPERTIES

This is also true of spiritual trees of life.

- It has its own vitality.
- It has an <u>effect</u> on the world around it.

## OUR PERFECT MODEL AND EXAMPLE OF THE SPIRITUAL TREE OF LIFE – THE LORD JESUS CHRIST

#### HOW JESUS WAS THE PERFECT EXAMPLE

- His roots of righteousness were deep and far-reaching.
- He bore sound fruit. (Gal. 5:22)
- His fruit is still greatly sought after.
- His service to man is still <u>gentle</u> and simple, but amply protective and <u>comforting</u>.

MAN'S TENDENCY IS TO REPRODUCE GOD'S TREE OF LIFE IN OUR OWN WAY

JESUS CHRIST GAVE US THE KEY TO TRUE MINISTRY IN THE SPIRIT AT THE BEGINNING OF HIS EARTHLY MINISTRY

#### LESSON 4

#### HIS WAY IS LOWLY

- Luke 4:18 "The <u>Spirit of the Lord</u> is upon me, because He hath <u>anointed</u> me to preach the gospel to the poor, He hath sent me to heal the broken-hearted, to preach deliverance to the captives and the recovering of sight to the blind, to set at liberty the bruised, to preach the acceptable year of the Lord (full atonement and liberty for sins at cross and resurrection)."
- Zechariah 4:6 Jesus let us know that His ministry would not be "by might nor by power," but by God's Holy Spirit.
  - Man has a tendency to set his heart on the <u>might</u> and <u>power</u>, rather than the <u>Spirit</u> of might and power.
  - If we want to see the greater works, we need to get our eyes and our hearts on <u>Jesus</u> and the <u>Spirit</u> that was upon Him, and off the works of power and might.

#### WHAT CHARACTERIZED THE SPIRIT THAT WAS ON JESUS?

JESUS HAD A LOWLY, <u>MEEK</u>, HUMBLE, PATIENT, AND KIND SPIRIT (MATT. 11:29)

#### MEEKNESS AND LOWLINESS OF HEART EQUALS POWER

- The Spirit of God is a Spirit of power. (Acts 1:8)
- The Spirit of power is given and expressed through the <u>meek</u> and humble.
  - Men of the Bible who were meek, humble, lowly and had the power of God.
    - Abraham Father of Faith. (Gen. 18:27)
    - Jacob Father of God's bride, Israel. (Gen. 32:10)
    - Moses Deliverer of the nation of Israel out of bondage in Egypt. (Ex. 3:11; Num. 12:3)
    - David the mightiest and greatest King on earth. (2 Sam. 7:18)
    - Solomon the greatest wisdom of any on earth and ruled with power. (1 Kings 3:7)

### LESSON 4

#### HIS WAY IS LOWLY

- Isaiah powerfully used. (Isaiah 6:5, 38:15)
- Jeremiah a powerfully used prophet.
   (Jer. 10:23)
- John the Baptist the greatest man ever born to woman. (John 1:27)
- Paul exemplified power of God more than any other since Pentecost. (Rom. 7:18; Phil. 4:12; Eph. 3:8; 1 Cor. 15:9)
- Other examples: Joseph, Samuel, Josiah, Job, Elizabeth, Mary, Stephen, Peter, John
- God uses the <u>meek</u> and <u>lowly</u> of heart. In fact, the <u>power</u> of God is always to the meek, lowly, and humble of spirit (Psalm 138:6; Prov. 22:4, 29:23, 11:2; Isaiah 57:15; Micah 6:8; Matt. 5:3; Luke 17:10; 1 Cor. 10:12; Eph. 4:1-2; Phil. 2:4-8)

#### CONCLUSION

IF WE ARE TO BE <u>REPRODUCTIONS</u> OF THE TRUE TREE OF LIFE AND BRING THE SHADE AND PROTECTIVE REFRESHING TO THIS EARTH, WE MUST BE MEEK, HUMBLE, AND GENTLE. HOW?

- Remain vitally <u>united</u> to Christ who was meek, lowly, humble and gentle. (John 15:4; Gal. 2:20)
- Do the work of the kingdom as He did, never drawing attention to ourselves, but giving all the glory to the Father. (John 15:8; John 17:4)
- Be like Paul, who understood that meekness and lowliness of heart equal <u>power</u> – "when I am weak, then I am strong."
   (2 Cor. 12:5-6, 12:10; 1 Peter 5:5; James 4:6)

WE MUST DAILY KEEP OURSELVES IN LINE IF WE ARE TO MINISTER IN THE SPIRIT AND POWER OF JESUS AND BE TRUE SPIRITUAL TREES OF LIFE, BOTH IN EXAMPLE AND SERVICE.
