

Marked by Love

INTRODUCTION

Did you know that as Christians we have an actual identifier? This identifier is a "mark" of love (for both God and others) that makes known we are followers of Christ.

Jesus said to him, "You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your mind.' This is the first and great commandment. And the second is like it: 'You shall love your neighbor as yourself.' On these two commandments hang all the Law and the Prophets." Matthew 22:37-40 (NKJV)

"A new commandment I give to you, that you love one another; as I have loved you, that you also love one another. By this all will know that you are My disciples, if you have love for one another." John 13:34-35 (NKJV)

Jesus did not say that loving God and others would be a natural result of becoming a Christian. In fact, He implied that loving might be difficult at times, as shown by His command of us to love. Commandments require both obedience and submission. Jesus knew that we would have to consistently submit our will to Him in order to consistently show love. The degree of our submission is an indication of our love for Him. I am loved so I obey. NOT I obey so I will be loved!

The Bible is filled with examples of "walking out love."

In "The Good Samaritan" parable, Jesus teaches us to love ALL men (including our enemies). (Luke 10:30-37)

We show love by sympathizing with those experiencing sadness, and by rejoicing with those who are experiencing joy. (Romans 12:15; 1 Cor. 12:26)

We are to show love by forgiving those who hurt or offend us. (Matt. 18:21-22, Eph. 4:23)

We are to show love by LOVINGLY correcting our fellow Christians. (Matt. 18:15-17)

Love is patient and kind. (1 Cor. 13:4-8)

GOD IS LOVE. Everything that Jesus did during His ministry on earth was done in love. He was love defined. Jesus lived love. The better we know God, the more we'll understand how to love since He is love!

Let all that you do be done with love. 1 Corinthians 16:14 (NKJV)
