It was used as ransom or the atonement money. (Exodus 30:11-16)





JESUS CAME TO FULFILL THE LAW.

- The trumpet in scripture is used to symbolize the prophetic voice, the spoken Word. The prophets were told to lift up their "voice like a trumpet" (Isaiah 58:1; Hosea 8:1).
- The voice of the Lord Jesus is symbolized also by the sound of the trumpet (Revelation 1:10,4:1).
- ➤ For Israel, Aaron and his sons were responsible as priests to sound the trumpet message on special occasions. (Exodus 28:1).

TRUMPETS IN SCRIPTURE

The Lord is a warrior; The Lord is his name. Exodus 15:3.

The Lord will march out like a champion, like a warrior he will stir up his zeal; with a shout he will raise the battle cry and will

triumph over his enemies. Isaiah 42:13.

## MOED AND HOLY CONVOCATION

Deuteronomy 16:16 Three times a year all your men must appear before the Lord your God at the place he will choose: at the Festival of Unleavened Bread, The Festival of Weeks and the Festival of Tabernacles

Exodus 23:1-16. Three times a year you are to celebrate a festival to me....celebrate the Festival of Ingathering at the end of the year, when you gather in your crops from the field. Three times a year all the men are to appear before the Sovereign Lord.





# BAR TAILED GODWHIT

- When a Feast took place on earth, there was something which took place in heaven. Jesus Christ brings heaven and earth together bridging the communication gap brought about by sin.
- ► He Himself said: "all power is given unto Me in Heaven and in Earth (Matt 28:18.) He is our Melchizedek, Priest of the Most High God. Possessor of heaven and earth. He is our "Jacob's Ladder" which connects heaven and earth.

#### HEAVEN AND EARTH CONNECTIONS

- In Passover as Jesus was sacrificed on the earth, the sun in heaven was darkened by God the Father.
- In Unleavened Bread and First Fruits Christ was resurrected from the grave on earth and ascended to heaven presenting Himself as surety for all believers.
- In Pentecost, Jesus had ascended to heaven and sent back to earth His Holy Spirit for the waiting disciples, who formed the church the body of Christ, in its conception.
- In the Day of Atonement Jesus, entered within the heavenly veil, of the heavenly Sanctuary, and the believers on earth has access to the throne of God.


HEAVEN AND EARTH

So the Lord stirred up the spirit of Zerubbabel....and the spirit of Joshua son of Jozadak, the high priest, and the spirit of the whole remnant of the people. They came and began to work on the house of the Lord Almighty, their God.

Stir Up = Uroor To awaken, raise up, to incite, to arouse to action. Occurring about 75 times in the OT, it is used of an eagle stirring up its nest (Deut 32:11) and of a musical instrument being awakened or warmed up for playing (Psalm 108:2). In Isa 50:4, the Lord awakens the prophet each morning and "awakens" his ear to hear God's message. Isaiah 51:9 speaks of the arm of the Lord being awakened or roused into act

#### COMMANDER OF THE ARMY



Revelation 19:11-16. Luke 1:68-71. When Zacharias learned that the Messiah was to be born, he declared these words: "Blessed is the Lord God of Israel, for he has visited and redeemed His people, and has raised up a 'horn of salvation' for us in the house of His Servant David."



#### **EXODUS 19 AND I THESSALONIANS 4**

Exodus 19:16, 19,20. ..there was thunder and lightning, with a thick cloud over the mountain, and a very loud trumpet blast. Everyone in the camp trembled...... As the sound of the trumpet grew louder and louder, Moses spoke and the voice of the Lord answered him.

Exodus 20:18. When the people saw thunder and lightning and heard the trumpet and saw the mountain in smoke, they trembled with fear.

I Thessalonians 4:16. For the Lord himself will come down from heaven, with a loud command, with the voice of the archangel and with the trumpet call of God, and the dead in Christ will rise first.





Living consciously is seeking to be aware of everything that bears on our interests, actions, values, purposes, and goals.


#### THE ART OF LIVING CONSCIOUSLY

#### THE LIES WE BELIEVE

The Lord said to Moses: "Make two trumpets of hammered silver, and use them for calling the community together and for having the camps set out. When both are sounded, the whole community is to assemble before you at the entrance to the Tent of Meeting. If only one is sounded, the leaders – are to assemble before you. When you go into battle in your own land against an enemy who is oppressing you, sound a blast from the trumpets. Then you will be remembered by the Lord your God and rescued from your enemies. Also at your times of rejoicing – your appointed feasts and New Moon festivals you are to sound the trumpet.

**USE OF TRUMPETS** 



#### 1. FOR THE SOUNDING OF AN ALARM

At times the trumpet was blown to warn the people of that which was coming.

Joel 2:1, Amos 3:6-7, Numbers 10:5-7.

{ N.T} So today God sounds an alarm to His church to warn her of coming events in the world and thus cause the church to seek His face.

Trumpets were blown in times of war and enemy oppression. When God heard the trumpet He would fight for his people and bring down deliverance. Jeremiah 4:19, 21, Judges 3:27, 6:34, 7:4-22, Numbers 31:6-7.

{N.T.} So the Church in times of enemy oppression may call on the name of the Lord and experience great deliverance. Acts 10:38, Ephesians 6:10-18.

#### 2. FOR WAR OR ENEMY OPPRESSION

When the cloud moved, then the trumpets were blown and the people were to move on with God. Numbers 9:15-23, 10:2, 11-36.

{ N.T.} So the church today must follow the Cloud of God's Holy Spirit as He leads the way. Acts 1:8, 20:28.

#### 3. FOR THE JOURNEYING OF THE CAMP

The tribes gathered as one nation. The trumpet used to call Israel, God's people together. Isaiah 27:13, Numbers 10:10.

{N.T} So the Church gathers as one under the name of the Lord Jesus Christ. Psalm 50:5, Matthew 18:20.

At the coming of Christ the trumpet will sound and gather together all the elect from the four corners of the earth.

Matthew 24:30-31.

#### 4. FOR SOLEMN ASSEMBLIES

When the leadership of Israel were called to gather, only one trumpet was blown. Two trumpets would sound when the whole nation or the whole congregation was to be called. Numbers 10:4.

{ N.T.} So today the Holy Spirit calls together leadership for special convocations that He may speak to them and give them direction.

# 5. FOR THE CALLING TOGETHER OF LEADERS

There were times of great joy and gladness during the various festival occasions. The trumpet was blown as the people rejoiced before the Lord with the sounding of the trumpet. This is seen in The Tabernacle of David order of worship.

1 Chronicles 13:8, 15:24-29, 15:24-29, Psalm 47,50.

{ N.T.} So the church experiences days of gladness and joy as she gathers together to worship the Lord in Festival days as well as on the Lord's day. Colossians 1:12, Psalm 100:2.

#### 6. FOR DAYS OF GLADNESS

All the Feast days and all the beginning of months were announced by the sound of the blowing of trumpets. These trumpet sounds were to keep God's "times and seasons" in the people's minds. Exodus 19:6-13, Leviticus 23:24-25.

{N.T.} So the church at times is called by the Lord to times and seasons of intercession and special prayer and fasting.

Joel 1:14, Mark 2:18-20, Mark 9:29,

1 Thessalonians 5:1, Acts 3:19-21.

#### 7. FOR THE BEGINNING OF MONTHS

As the sacrifices were being offered upon the altar the trumpets were also blown. As the Lord heard the silvery note of redemption ascending over the ascending sacrifices, so He would remember His promise to accept His people through the blood atonement. Numbers 29:1-6, 2 Chronicles 29:27-28.

{ N.T.} So the Lord accepts the church (individual believer-priests) through Christ. The believer offers spiritual sacrifices of joy and praise acceptable to God. Hebrews 13:15-16, Revelation 1:6, 5:9-10,I Peter 2:5-9.

#### 8. FOR OFFERINGS AND SACRIFICE

#### HEAVEN AND EARTH





Finally, when the final and last trumpet blows, then Jesus descends from heaven to earth and receives his own to Himself. And at long last "THE TABERNACE OF GOD" will be with men and He will dwell with them. It will indeed be "heaven on earth".
